Shane commented that Laura had received a grant for the pumpkin patch activity to be held in October.

Motion by DeMont seconded by Stan to approve the 2nd Reading of the ORD 20-03. Motion Carried

Motion to approve the ORD 20-04 on the 2nd Reading by DeMont seconded by Stan. 3 no votes. Motion fails

Motion by Stan to adjourn the meeting at 8:57 seconded by DeMont. Motion Carried
